BACK TO THE FUTURE



Nikki Bradley is an adaptive adventurer and speaker who was given a second chance at the tender age of 16.

The diagnosis of a rare form of bone cancer called Ewing's Sarcoma changed Nikki's life direction.

She is the founder of fitness based awareness campaign 'Fighting Fit For Ewing's' which involves participating in physical challenges such as an attempted Guinness World Record in Holland, climbing the route of the Solheimajokull glacier in Iceland and completing the Fan Dance which is a gruelling 24km trek through the snowy Brecon Beacons in Wales, all while relying heavily on crutches.

In July 2018, Nikki became the first crutch user to climb 4 Irish mountains on crutches in less than 32 hours.

It is hope that gives life meaning. And hope is based on the prospect of being able one day to turn the actual world into a possible one that looks better.
